Discus chapter insurance requirements - Hagerty annual quote \$388. D&O \$345.

What type of organization is OCP and insurance? voted for type 501(c)7

Greg question - <u>QUOTE</u> - Directors & Officers – protects the Board of Directors if someone thinks OCP's resources were mishandled by the Board of Directors. This insurance prevents the claiming person from having access to each of the Board members personal assets. <u>How do they accomplish</u> this?

Roger contacted agent Zach Bronstein, the insurance agent we have been dealing with representing Hagerty, yesterday and posed Greg's question. Here are the key points assuming OCP purchased D&O insurance.

- If someone feels a board member or the entire board has acted in a negligent or illegal manner, that person would typically file a lawsuit
- Upon receiving the lawsuit, OCP would file a claim with the insurance company
- The insurance company would consider the charges and board's actions
- If the Board or a member of the Board did something that was illegal, the insurance company would decline the claim and the Board would be on its own
- If the insurance company found the Board to have acted in a legal manner, their attorney would work toward a resolution
- Attorney fees would be the insurance company's responsibility, although there are some "fine print" exceptions that we did not cover
- Claims settled by paying the claiming person would be up to the purchased coverage maximum, which according to Zach is \$1 million for the quoted policy
- Up to the \$1 million policy limit, the board members personal assets would be insulated from the claiming person
