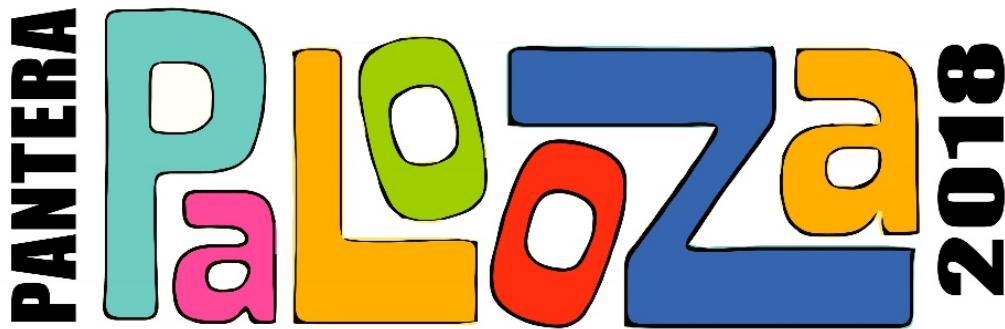
**Amazing!**
